3.1. D19 Student Academic Record (Records, Grading & Academic Standing)

Briefing Note / Policy / Track Changes (D.Andrus-Dobbs)

- This policy was due for its regular review cycle.
- The content in policy D19 was aligned with the D32 and D49 policies. Thus, there is a proposal to combine D19, D32 and D49 into one policy.

- There was a thorough consultation process, which involved engaging with counterparts in TLCI, faculty and students.
- This revised policy helps enhance the information that is being shared with other PSIs.

4.1. New Post Diploma Certificates

- 4.1.1. <u>New Post Diploma Certificates Research and Engagement Report</u> (FIO)
- **4.1.2.** <u>PDC BUPM Post-Diploma Certificate Business Project Management</u> (D.Bullock)
 - Olds College has an existing Advanced Education approved program titled "Post Diploma" with 4 majors: Agricultural Business, Agriculture, Horticulture, and Environment.
 - The Werklund School of Agriculture Technology and the School of Life Science and Business are collaboratively proposing a name change to the existing "Agricultural Business" major to "Business". Under this renamed major, the schools will offer programming with three areas of focus: 1) Agricultural Business, 2) Project Management, and 3) Supply Chain Management.
 - The intent is to launch this PDC in September 2025 and on campus face to face.
 - We plan to work with Project Management Institute (PMI) to develop these courses to be consistent and provide a pathway for students wishing to write their exam.

- 4.1.3. PDC BUSM Post-Diploma Certificate Business Supply Chain Management (D. Bullock)
 - Olds College has an existing Advanced Education approved program titled "Post Diploma" with 4 majors: Agricultural Business, Agriculture, Horticulture, and Environment.
 - The Werklund School of Agriculture Technology and the School of Life Science and Business are collaboratively proposing a name change to the existing "Agricultural Business" major to "Business". Under this renamed major, the schools will offer programming with three areas of focus: 1) Agricultural Business, 2) Project Management, and 3) Supply Chain Management.
 - Supply Chain Canada would be a model for the development of this program.

• The Registrar's Office will follow up with the Recruitment Team to ensure that the language, particularly around the undergraduate PDC credential level, is clear and consistent in promotional materials and recruitment channels.

- **4.1.4.** <u>PDCITCC Post-Diploma Certificate Information Technology Cloud Computing</u> (*J.Steeves*)
 - Environmental scanning, conducted in July 2023, indicated that programming in the area of cloud computing demonstrates high student demand and sustained employment opportunities.
 - The Werklund School of Agriculture Technology is proposing an Information Technology major in the Post-Diploma Certificate program, with a concentration in Cloud Computing.
 - The value proposition of this program is the connection to the agriculture support piece; plus, the WIL component that is agriculturally focused.
 - By not specifying the Cloud Computing concentration under the Agriculture PDC, there are broader opportunities for students to take under the IT PDC.

 - The Werklund School of Agriculture Technology is proposing an Information Technology major in the Post-Diploma Certificate program, with a concentration in Cybersecurity.

- This new program is a copy of the Post-Diploma Certificate Agricultural Business (Specialization). The rationale for creating this as a separate program is administrative, allowing the College to best accommodate multiple schools that manage the Business post-diploma certificates.
- This structure will allow for flexibility to handle the complexities behind this in a clean fashion within Kuali Curriculum Management to provide clarity and transparency.
